Basic Eagles Requirements:

- Be at least 50 years of age and reside in one of the following counties: **Indiana:** Elkhart, LaGrange, Steuben, Kosciusko, Noble, DeKalb, Whitley, Allen, Wabash, Huntington, Adams, Wells, Jay, Blackford; **Ohio:** Williams, Defiance, Paulding, VanWert, Mercer; **Michigan:** Branch, Hillsdale, St. Joseph.
- Maintain a \$5 minimum balance in a ProFed Regular Share Account.

Golden Eagles

Additional Requirements:

- Have a \$2,000 minimum balance in any one ProFed Share Account (\$4,000 if spouse is joint Golden Eagle).*
- Hold a ProFed Checking Account or be joint on spouse's checking account.
- Use Direct Deposit for Social Security, pension or payroll checks, if applicable.

* A \$5 monthly fee will be assessed for any month the Golden Eagle member fails to maintain the minimum balance in at least one share account for the entire month.
