CARROLL R. PHILLIPS SCHOLARSHIP

PROFED CREDIT UNION



This scholarship is intended to provide qualified **high school seniors** with financial assistance to pursue educational goals beyond their high school diplomas. Four \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded annually in time to apply toward fall enrollment.

Please complete and submit the scholarship application with all required documents either by mail, in person at any branch location or electronically to scholarships@profedcu.org.

APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED OR POSTMARKED BY APRIL 13, 2018.

ELIGIBILITY

The scholarship may be applied for if the applicant is:

- A member of ProFed Credit Union in good standing
- Any family member of a ProFed Credit Union member in good standing
- A high school senior

The applicant must be a full-time student who is accepted at, and enrolled in a two or four-year program at an accredited college, university, trade school or vocational school. This may include apprenticeship programs. Final decisions on eligibility will be made by the ProFed Scholarship Committee.

Scholarship recipients are required to attend a presentation ceremony or have family representation at the ceremony. Scholarships will not be awarded to those not in attendance. Applicants may receive only one scholarship from ProFed Credit Union in any calendar year.

REQUIRED FORMS

The ProFed Scholarship Committee will review the confidential statement of each eligible candidate. To be considered, each applicant's file **MUST** contain these **COMPLETED** forms:

- Carroll R. Phillips Scholarship Application Form completed by applicant
- A copy of the applicant's most recent high school, college, university, trade school or vocational school transcript
- Proof of enrollment (***upcoming fall class schedule or college letter of acceptance***) at an accredited school, college, university, trade school, vocational school or apprenticeship program
- A letter of recommendation prepared by a school official who is knowledgeable about the applicant through class work or extracurricular activities or by any employment supervisor of the applicant
- An essay from the applicant explaining his/her educational objectives and why he/she has selected them

Essays should be no less than one full page in length and may be typed or handwritten in ink. Essays should also be double spaced with a 12 point font maximum. Please proofread for spelling and grammar.

The applicant is responsible for completing and submitting all necessary forms by the

APRIL 13, 2018 DEADLINE.

EVALUATIVE CRITERIA

Applicants will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Grade Point Average
- Community Service/Community Involvement
- Extracurricular Student Activities/Job Experiences/Internships
- Written Essay

ANNOUNCEMENT

All applicants will be notified by letter regarding the results of the ProFed Scholarship Committee's decision. The four recipients will be notified by telephone and/or letter. An announcement to the Credit Union membership will be in all newsletters and posted on ProFed Credit Union's internet home page.

AMOUNT AND PAYMENT

A \$1,000.00 check will be made payable to the recipient and to the school, college, university, trade school, vocational school or apprenticeship program. The check will be presented to the recipient in time for fall enrollment.

THE PROFED SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

The members of the ProFed Scholarship Committee will be appointed each year by the chairperson of the ProFed Credit Union Board of Directors.
